

Rules for the 2009 Triple Crown How to use your Mulligan!

All participants for the Triple Crown Awards must shoot (3) three out of the (4) four scheduled shoots with the Bowhunter Happening being mandatory. ie: A participant may shoot all three qualifying events, the 1st, 2nd and 3rd legs, and he or she may use the score from one of those three events as a Mulligan (*throw it out*) **only three scores will be used to determine the winner of the Triple Crown in each class.**

The three scores would be the Bowhunter Happening score and two of the three from the qualifying shoots.

That also allows a participant to miss (1) one out of the first three (3) events if need should arise and still be able to qualify for the Triple Crown.

Keep in mind that it will be beneficial to all participants to shoot all events *and then, be able to discard your lowest score.*

(the score from the BHH would be a mandatory score and would not be eligible as the Mulligan)
